


## Taste of the Atlantic

#### Day 1 - Tue Sep 02 Home city to Halifax

Meals Included: Welcome Reception

Depart from your hometown today on convenient flights to Halifax, marking the beginning of an exciting tour. Upon arrival, if you have chosen the group flight option or your own flights that have the same arrival time, transportation to The Atlantica is arranged, where you'll stay for two nights. This evening, a Welcome Reception offers the chance to meet fellow travelers. Anticipate the adventures that await as you settle in and prepare for the journey ahead.

### Day 2 - Wed Sep 03 Peggy's Cove, Lunenburg, Halifax City Tour

Meals Included: Breakfast

Today's journey will explore Nova Scotia's picturesque coastal gems, from the most photographed lighthouse to the historic grid-patterned town. This includes the iconic Peggy's Cove Lighthouse, and the well-preserved British colonial architecture of Lunenburg for a walking tour. On our return, we will have a city tour of Halifax before ending back at our hotel and an evening on your own to explore.

# Day 3 - Thurs Sep 04 Halifax to Saint John Meals Included: Breakfast

This morning after checkout we will visit Pier 21. If your ancestors landed in Halifax they will have every detail of their arrival on Canadian soil. Call them before your tour and they will have all the documents prepared for you upon our arrival.

Then we are off to our Hilton Hotel in downtown Saint John right on the harbour for another 2-night stay. There are plenty of dining options very close to the Waterfront Container village which has music culture and gift shopping of all sorts.

# Day 4 - Fri Sep o5 Reversing Falls, St Andrews by the Sea Meals Included: Breakfast

Today we will view the Reversing Falls, before making our way to St. Andrews by the Sea. The historic town is a national historic site of Canada, bearing many characteristics of a typical 18th century British colonial settlement. On our return to Saint John we will visit the Saint John Skywalk for a short video and fantastic view of the Reversing Falls for a different view of the tide as it enters or exits the Saint John River from the Bay of Fundy.

### Day 5 - Sat Sep o6 Hopewell Rocks and Confederation Bridge

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch

Embarking on a scenic drive we explore the Hopewell Rocks with a guided tour, enjoy an included lunch, and snap photos with the world's largest lobster in Shediak. We traverse the impressive Confederation Bridge to Prince Edward Island, marveling at its engineering prowess, and make a stop at Gateway Village. Our journey culminates at the Quality Inn in Charlottetown, where we'll stay for two nights, surrounded by the natural wonder of the world's highest tides.

# Day 6 - Sun Sep o7 Charlottetown and Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place Meals Included: Breakfast, Dinner

An exciting day awaits as we head out on a Charlottetown tour. We will visit the Anne of Green Gables Heritage Place, stroll Cavendish Beach, and savor a traditional PEI Ceilidh and oyster shucking. The day includes a Fisherman's Wharf Lobster Feast with a vast salad bar and seafood delights. Evening brings freedom to explore Charlottetown, after experiencing the world of L.M. Montgomery and her beloved Anne Shirley.

### Day 7 - Mon Sep 08 Charlottetown to Baddeck

Meals Included: Breakfast, Dinner

Departing PEI we will make the short drive to the Wood Island-Pictou Ferry for a short crossing back to Nova Scotia. Once on the mainland we cross the Canso Causeway which connects to Cape Breton Island. Arriving in the quaint town of Baddeck at one of our favourite properties the Lynwood Inn where you will have time to stroll the water front before or after dinner. Tonight we will have an included dinner in the Lynwood restaurant. You will be seated at private tables with your traveling partners.

#### Day 8 - Tue Sep 09 The Cabot Trail

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch

Embarking on a scenic journey, today's tour features the breathtaking Cape Breton Island and the renowned Cabot Trail, lauded by Lonely Planet. As we circle the trail, we'll pause for photos, enjoy a picnic in the Cape Breton Highlands National Park, and bid our Nova Scotia guide farewell before heading to Newfoundland. The trail, named after explorer John Cabot, links diverse communities and celebrates over 500 years of history with the Mi'kmaq people.

#### Day 9 - Wed Sep 10 Ferry to Port aux Basques to Corner Brook

Meals Included: Breakfast

Embark on a 6.5-hour ferry journey from North Sydney to Port aux Basques, enjoying amenities like lounges, restaurants, and entertainment on Marine Atlantic Ferry. Relax in easy chairs with TV programming, or explore the deck for marine life sightings. Once we arrive, we will continue our journey to Corner Brook our evening destination.

# Day 10 - Thurs Sep 11 Corner Brook to Rocky Harbour Meals Included: Breakfast

This morning we will visit the Captain Cook Historic Site, before carrying on for lunch at Deer Lake where we will meet our local Newfoundland guide, who will guide us on to Rocky Harbor where we will first have a boat tour of Bonne Bay including a deluxe Screech-In Ceremony. (Get ready to kiss the cod fish and have a shot of Screech!). We will then check into the Ocean View Hotel for the next two evenings. You will have the evening on your own where they always have local entertainment in the Lounge.

#### Day 11 - Fri Sep 12 Rocky Harbour

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch

Embarking on a Gros Morne adventure, you'll explore the historic Lobster Cove Lighthouse, marvel at the natural wonder of the Arches, and delve into the heritage of Broom Point's fishing community. (Broom Point may still be closed as it has been undergoing renovations) A stroll and lunch at Cow Head's Shallow Bay precede our return to Rocky Harbour, you will have some free time before an evening Anchors Aweigh Show by the same cast from our boat tour yesterday. Do not forget to check out the amazing sunset as it disappears over the Gulf of St. Lawrence.

# Day 12 - Sat Sep 13 Rocky Harbour to Gander Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch

Departing Gros Morne, we journey to Gander, pausing at King's Point to explore the Humpback Whale Pavilion and enjoy lunch at By the Sea Café, with time to visit the acclaimed King's Point Pottery shop. In Gander, we'll delve into aviation history at the North Atlantic Aviation Museum before settling into Sinbad's Inn and Suites, where our luggage awaits in our rooms for a two-night stay.

# Day 13 - Sun Sep 14 Twillingate Day Tour Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch

Embark on a day trip to Twillingate, with stops at the Beothuk Interpretive Centre and Ancient Gardens. Explore Twillingate's rich history, enjoy a scenic tour, savor lunch and wine tasting at Auk Island Winery, and visit local cultural sites. Cap off the experience with a breathtaking view from Long Point Lighthouse, a treat at the Lightkeeper's Fudgery.

### Day 14 - Mon Sep 15 Gander To St John's

Meals Included: Breakfast

Today you depart Gander for St. John's. We start with a stop at the Silent Witness Memorial, a tranquil park dedicated to the memory of the 256 individuals who lost their lives on December 12, 1985 in the Arrow Air Crash. If time permits, we will stop for a photo stop at Joseph Smallwood's Lookout. We will also visit Petty Harbour and Cape Spear (North America's most easterly point) on our way to St. John's for our final two evenings.

### Day 15 - Tue Sep 16 St. John's Area

Meals Included: Breakfast, Farewell Dinner

Embark on a day filled with exploration in St. John's, starting with the breathtaking Cape Spear, North America's easternmost point, and the historic Signal Hill, known for its panoramic views and Marconi's wireless signal triumph. Enjoy a city tour and Lucky Rocks adventure before a Farewell Dinner at the hotel, offering a chance to bid adieu to your guide and companions ahead of early departures.
