Discover a range of fascinating attractions: tour the Royal Canadian Mint, where Canadian coins come to life; come face to face with polar bears and Arctic wildlife at the Journey to Churchill exhibit; and step back in time on the boardwalks of Boomtown 1910 at the Western Development Museum in Saskatoon.

Day 1 – Fri Jul 31 *St. Albert, AB to Regina, SK – Prairie Horizons Await*

Meals Included: None

Begin your journey across the Canadian heartland as you depart St. Albert and travel east through the open expanse of Alberta and into Saskatchewan. Along the way, meet fellow traveller's joining the tour from communities en route — new faces who will soon become familiar companions on this shared adventure. The road stretches wide beneath endless prairie skies, flanked by fields of wheat, barley, and canola that sway like oceans of gold and green. Pass scenes of rural life — rustic barns, classic grain elevators, and timeless stretches of open land that speak to the soul of the Prairies. Arrive in Regina, SK, where warm hospitality welcomes you for your first overnight stay.

Day 2 – Sat Aug 01 *Regina, SK to Winnipeg, MB – Gateway to the Heart of Manitoba*

Meals Included: Breakfast

Continue east through the wide-open plains of southeastern Saskatchewan, where vast fields meet endless skies. As you cross the provincial border into Manitoba, the prairie landscape subtly transforms — low-lying farmland gives way to gently rolling terrain, ribboned with rivers and dotted with small lakes. The road unfolds through rich agricultural country, reflecting the strength and simplicity of prairie life. By late afternoon, arrive in Winnipeg, MB — Manitoba's vibrant capital and your home base for the next four nights.

Day 3 – Sun Aug 02 *A Day of Viking Discovery – Where Icelandic Heritage Meets Lake Winnipeg*

Meals Included: Breakfast

Head north to the lakeside town of Gimli for the Icelandic Festival of Manitoba — the most authentic celebration of Icelandic heritage in Canada. With roots dating back to 1890, this storied festival offers a full day of Viking discovery: marvel at traditional costumes, explore artisan markets, and sample Icelandic specialties like vínarterta and rúgbrauð. Snap a photo at the iconic Viking statue, stroll the scenic boardwalk along Lake Winnipeg, and enjoy lively entertainment that brings Old World traditions to life. A rare cultural treasure by the water's edge.

Day 4 – Mon Aug 03 *Cultures in Motion – Capital Sights and Folklorama Nights*

Discover Winnipeg's rich history and character on a guided city tour, highlighting landmarks, distinctive neighbourhoods, and the beauty of this prairie capital. At The Forks Market, enjoy time to browse unique shops and taste local flavours. See the city from a new perspective on a scenic boat cruise along its waterways. In the evening, immerse yourself in Folklorama — the largest and longest-running multicultural festival in the world — visiting three pavilions filled with authentic performances, cuisine, and warm hospitality.

Day 5 – Tue Aug 04 *A World of Flavour – Mint Treasures, Arctic Encounters, and Folklorama Nights*

Begin the day at the Royal Canadian Mint, where every Canadian circulation coin is produced. Learn about the art and precision behind coin production and take home fascinating insights — and maybe a unique souvenir. Continue to Assiniboine Park Zoo for the acclaimed Journey to Churchill exhibit, one of the world's most comprehensive Arctic wildlife experiences. Watch polar bears swim gracefully, see seals at play, and discover the wonders of the North. In the evening, enjoy Folklorama's second night, visiting three new pavilions to explore fresh performances, flavors, and traditions from around the world.

Day 6 – Wed Aug 05 *Winnipeg, MB to Saskatoon, SK – Prairies in Motion Through Canada's Heartland*

Meals Included: Breakfast

Travel west along the Yellowhead Highway, where the Canadian prairies stretch endlessly in waves of gold and green. Pass by glistening prairie lakes, rows of weathered grain elevators, and charming small towns that speak to the heart of prairie life. The vast skies and ever-changing cloudscape create a moving panorama from horizon to horizon, offering a true sense of the land's scale and beauty. Arrive in Saskatoon, SK with the wide-open prairie still fresh in your memory.

Day 7 - Thurs Aug 06 *Saskatoon, SK to St. Albert, AB – Boomtown Memories and the Road Home*

Visit Saskatoon's Western Development Museum, where the Boomtown 1910 exhibit brings a prairie town to life. Step into the bustling main street lined with early 20th-century storefronts, vintage vehicles, and artifacts that capture the spirit of the era. After this journey through the past, continue west along the Yellowhead Highway toward St. Albert, AB. Rolling fields, big skies, and the familiar beauty of the prairie landscape accompany the final miles home, as fond farewells are shared with fellow travelers who have embraced the flavors, stories, and traditions that made this journey unforgettable.
