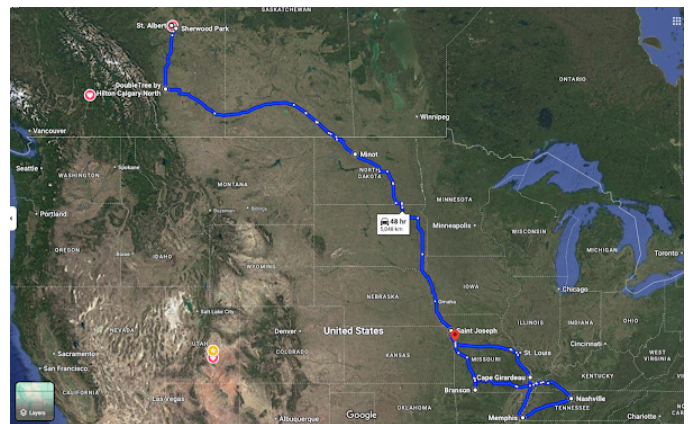
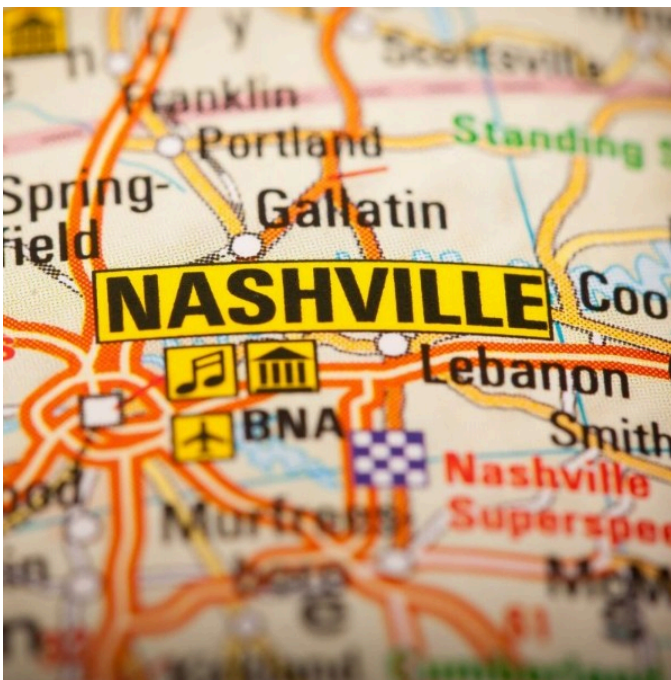

Day 1 – Fri Oct 23 *Pick Ups to Swift Current, SK – The Excitement Begins*

Meals Included: None

The journey begins with a spirit of adventure as you set out together, gathering fellow travelers and sharing in the excitement of what's to come. The open road stretches ahead, framed by wide prairie skies and rolling golden fields that seem to go on forever.

Along the way, enjoy the beauty of Alberta's sunlit plains and take in the sight of the striking Saamis Tepee in Medicine Hat, a proud symbol of Indigenous heritage and the world's tallest tepee. Crossing into Saskatchewan, the landscape welcomes you with its gentle charm and endless horizons—an inspiring start to your musical holiday.

Day 2 – Sat Oct 24 *Swift Current, SK to Minot, ND – Across the Prairies to North Dakota*

The vast prairie stretches endlessly in every direction, a patchwork of golden fields and big open skies. The journey carries you east to Moose Jaw, a city rich with character and prairie spirit, before continuing south through Weyburn and Estevan, where small-town charm and agricultural heritage shine through.

Crossing the border at Portal, you leave Canada behind and enter North Dakota, where new scenery and stories await. The day is filled with the quiet beauty of the plains and the growing anticipation of the adventures ahead on your Opry-Ozark holiday.

Day 3 – Sun Oct 25 *Minot, ND to Sioux Falls, SD – Buffalo Legends to Prairie Lakes*

The adventure continues southeast to Jamestown, home to the world's largest buffalo monument and a reminder of the prairies' wild past. From there, the journey carries you to Fargo, North Dakota's largest city, known for its welcoming spirit and lively heritage.

Crossing into South Dakota, the landscape transforms into the Prairie Pothole Region, a breathtaking stretch dotted with thousands of sparkling glacial lakes left behind from the last Ice Age. This remarkable scenery makes the day feel like a passage through both history and nature, as the open road leads ever closer to the heart of your musical holiday.

Day 4 – Mon Oct 26 *Sioux Falls, SD to St. Joseph, MO – Legends of the Old West*

In St. Joseph, step back in time with a guided visit to the Pony Express Museum, where the thrilling but short-lived mail service is brought to life. Continue your exploration at the Patee House Museum and Jesse James Home. Here, you can wander Old Main Street, admire artifacts from a bygone era, climb aboard a vintage steam engine, and stand in the very place where the infamous Jesse James met his fate. This day is filled with history, legend, and the spirit of adventure that makes the West so unforgettable.

Day 5 – Tue Oct 27 *St. Joseph, MO to Cape Girardeau, MO – Voices of the River*

Following the Mississippi south, the scenery shifts as you cross into Tennessee and arrive in Memphis, the birthplace of the blues. Stroll the neon glow of Beale Street, where live music and the scent of Southern cooking fill the air. The evening brings you close to music history itself, as you stay just steps away from Graceland, the iconic home of Elvis Presley.

Day 7 – Thurs Oct 29 *Memphis, TN to Nashville, TN – Elvis, Loretta, and Music City*

Continuing northeast, stop in Hurricane Mills, home of the Loretta Lynn Ranch. Here, exhibits honor the Coal Miner's Daughter, showcasing memorabilia, awards, and recreated scenes from her Kentucky childhood. Loretta's story unfolds with warmth, resilience, and authenticity—bringing her remarkable journey to life.

By evening, arrive in Nashville and check in for a four-night stay at the spectacular Gaylord Opryland Resort. With its lush indoor gardens, winding waterways, and festive atmosphere, this grand resort will be your home base as you experience the very best of Music City.

Arriving in Swift Current, you'll learn the city takes its name from the swift-flowing creek once noted by Hudson's Bay Company explorers. It's a fitting stop on the homeward path—rich in history, shaped by the land, and wrapped in the enduring spirit of the prairies.
