Day 1 - Sun Sep 27 Touchdown in Toronto - Gateway to the Falls - Let the Adventure Begin! Meals Included: Welcome Dinner

Day 2 - Mon Sep 28 Mist, Majesty & the Mighty Falls

As you take in the breathtaking scenery, enjoy a three-course lunch served onboard, blending the pleasures of fine dining with panoramic river views.

End your day at your own pace, perhaps with a sunset stroll back to Parliament Hill, or treasure hunting through the vibrant shops and cafés of ByWard Market—the evening is yours to savour.

Once a retreat for global leaders and dignitaries, today it is a UNESCO-recognized site and a testament to rustic elegance. Enjoy a delicious lunch in the grand dining room, followed by a guided tour that reveals the château's storied past and breathtaking riverside setting.

A short drive later brings us into the vibrant city of Montréal, where we check in for a two-night stay. The evening is yours to begin exploring this dynamic metropolis, known for its lively neighbourhoods, French-Canadian culture, and world-class cuisine.
