



# Rockies Waterfalls and Wells Gray Park

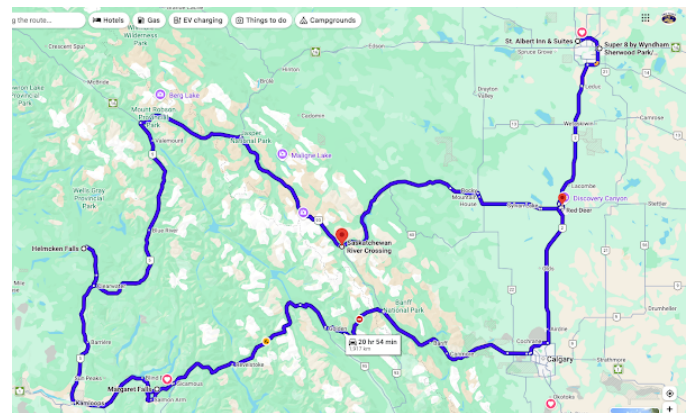
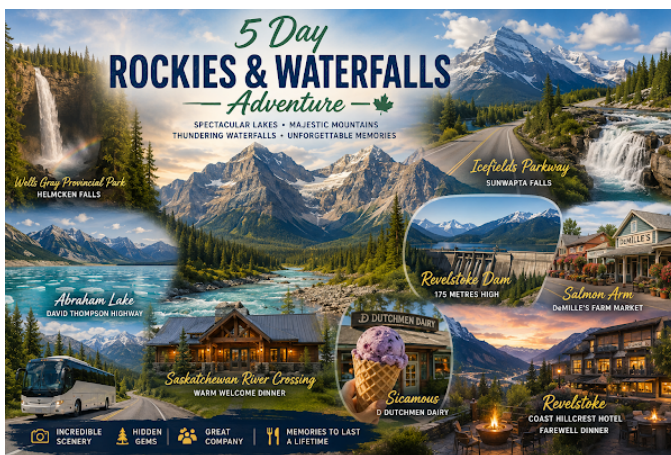

Discover some of Western Canada's most spectacular landscapes on a five-day adventure filled with turquoise lakes, towering peaks, thundering waterfalls and unforgettable mountain highways.

Follow the less-travelled David Thompson Highway past the brilliant waters of Abraham Lake to Saskatchewan River Crossing before journeying along the legendary Icefields Parkway, stopping at Sunwapta and Athabasca Falls. Beneath mighty Mount Robson, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies, enjoy an included lunch before crossing into British Columbia and continuing to Clearwater.

Venture deep into Wells Gray Provincial Park, where Spahats, Dawson and magnificent Helmcken Falls showcase the tremendous power and beauty of nature. Our route then winds through the colourful Shuswap, with stops at Margaret Falls and local favourites along the way before reaching Revelstoke for a tour of the impressive Revelstoke Dam and a special Farewell Dinner.

One final spectacular drive carries us home through Rogers Pass, Kicking Horse Pass and the Continental Divide, completing five unforgettable days through some of Alberta and British Columbia's most magnificent mountain country.

## **Day 1 – Fri May 28 *St, Albert to Saskatchewan River Crossing – The Road Less Travelled into the Rockies***

**Meals Included:** Welcome Dinner

Our adventure kicks off as we gather our fellow travellers and set out along the David Thompson Highway, a spectacular and less-travelled route leading from Central Alberta into the heart of the Rockies.

Stretch your legs at the Taunton Trestle, taking in sweeping valley views before continuing to Nordegg for a visit to the Nordegg Discovery Centre and a fascinating tour of the historic Brazeau Collieries.

The scenery becomes even more dramatic as we follow the brilliant blue waters of Abraham Lake, surrounded by rugged peaks and vast mountain wilderness. Our destination is Saskatchewan River Crossing, where we settle into our spectacular Rocky Mountain surroundings and gather for a hearty Welcome Dinner—the perfect chance to get acquainted with fellow travellers and new friends as our adventure begins.

## **Day 2 – Sat May 29 *Saskatchewan River Crossing, AB – Waterfalls, Glaciers & Mountain Giants***

**Meals Included:** Breakfast , Lunch

Our journey continues north along the legendary Icefields Parkway, where glaciers, turquoise rivers and towering peaks create spectacular views around every bend. Stops at the thundering Sunwapta Falls and powerful Athabasca Falls bring us up close to two of Jasper National Park's most impressive natural wonders.

Following a brief stop in Jasper, we turn west toward Mount Robson, rising 3,954 metres as the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. Pause beneath this mountain giant for an included lunch while soaking in the incredible surroundings.

From Valemount, our route turns south along the scenic Yellowhead Highway, travelling through the broad North Thompson Valley with the river winding alongside us. Forested mountains, rushing waterways and small communities accompany the drive as we pass through Blue River and gradually leave the towering Rockies behind for the lush landscapes of British Columbia's interior. Our destination is Clearwater, the gateway to magnificent Wells Gray Provincial Park and our home for the evening.

## **Day 3 – Sun May 30 *Clearwater – Wells Gray Park – Kamloops, BC – Canada's Waterfalls & Volcanoes Park***

**Meals Included:** Breakfast , Lunch

A spectacular day of waterfalls and wilderness awaits in Wells Gray Provincial Park. Our journey begins at Spahats Falls, followed by panoramic views across the Clearwater Valley and a walk among the towering trees of the Grove of Giants.

Deeper into the park, watch for glimpses of the extinct Pyramid Mountain volcano before arriving at Dawson Falls, where the Murtle River tumbles across an impressive 90-metre-wide cascade. Along the way, we'll pause for an included lunch amid the beautiful surroundings of Wells Gray before continuing past Mushbowl Canyon, another striking example of the powerful forces that shaped this remarkable landscape.

The showstopper is magnificent Helmcken Falls, plunging an awe-inspiring 141 metres over a volcanic cliff into the canyon below. Its tremendous power and dramatic wilderness setting provide a fitting finale to our Wells Gray adventure.

Retracing our route out of the park, we leave the waterfalls behind and follow the North Thompson Valley south toward Kamloops, watching the landscape gradually change from lush mountain forests to the rolling hills and open country of BC's Interior. Settle into the Coast Hotel for a relaxing evening after a memorable day surrounded by some of British Columbia's most spectacular natural wonders.

## **Day 4 – Mon May 31** *Kamloops to Revelstoke, BC – Spring Colours, Shuswap Shores & Mountain Power*

**Meals Included:** Breakfast , Ice Cream , Farewell Dinner

Our route swings east into the Shuswap, where spring colours the hillsides and the sparkling waters of Shuswap Lake accompany us through Sorrento and Blind Bay. At Herald Provincial Park, a short walk beneath towering cedars leads to beautiful Margaret Falls.

Continuing through Salmon Arm, enjoy a stop at DeMille's Farm Market before a sweet treat at D Dutchmen Dairy in Sicamous. Mountains rise around us once again as we reach Revelstoke for a tour of the impressive Revelstoke Dam Visitor Centre, where the tremendous scale of this 175-metre-high structure is matched by spectacular views across the Columbia River Valley.

Settle into the Coast Hillcrest Hotel, surrounded by beautiful mountain scenery, before gathering for a special Farewell Dinner to celebrate the adventures, spectacular sights and new friendships shared along the way.

## **Day 5 – Tue Jun 01** *Revelstoke, BC to Home Cities – Homeward bound over mountain passes*

**Meals Included:** Breakfast

It's time to begin our journey home, but the spectacular scenery is far from over. Leaving Revelstoke, we climb into Glacier National Park and ascend through the rugged Selkirk Mountains to Rogers Pass, one of the most dramatic stretches of the Trans-Canada Highway. A pause at the Rogers Pass Discovery Centre offers time to take in the sweeping mountain views and appreciate the remarkable story of transportation through this challenging alpine corridor.

Our route continues through Golden before climbing toward Kicking Horse Pass, where towering peaks and deep valleys accompany us to the Continental Divide. Crossing this natural boundary brings us back into Alberta and the familiar beauty of Lake Louise, Banff and Canmore as the Rockies gradually give way to the rolling foothills and open prairie.

As our five-day adventure draws to a close, we return to our original pickup locations with cameras full of spectacular scenery and memories of turquoise lakes, thundering waterfalls, mountain highways and hidden corners of Western Canada —along with new friendships and plenty of stories from the road.
