**St. Albert to Saskatchewan River Crossing - The Road Less Travelled into the Rockies**

Our adventure kicks off as we gather our fellow travellers and set out along the David Thompson Highway, a spectacular and less-travelled route leading from Central Alberta into the heart of the Rockies.

Stretch your legs at the Taunton Trestle, taking in sweeping valley views before continuing to Nordegg for a visit to the Nordegg Discovery Centre and a fascinating tour of the historic Brazeau Collieries.



The scenery becomes even more dramatic as we follow the brilliant blue waters of Abraham Lake, surrounded by rugged peaks and vast mountain wilderness. Our destination is Saskatchewan River Crossing, where we settle into our spectacular Rocky Mountain surroundings and gather for a hearty Welcome Dinner—the perfect chance to get acquainted with fellow travellers and new friends as our adventure begins.

## Day 2

A spectacular day of waterfalls and wilderness awaits in Wells Gray Provincial Park. Our journey begins at Spahats Falls, followed by panoramic views across the Clearwater Valley and a walk among the towering trees of the Grove of Giants.



Deeper into the park, watch for glimpses of the extinct Pyramid Mountain volcano before arriving at Dawson Falls, where the Murtle River tumbles across an impressive 90-metre-wide cascade. Along the way, we'll pause for an included lunch amid the beautiful surroundings of Wells Gray before continuing past Mushbowl Canyon, another striking example of the powerful forces that shaped this remarkable landscape.

The showstopper is magnificent Helmcken Falls, plunging an awe-inspiring 141 metres over a volcanic cliff into the canyon below. Its tremendous power and dramatic wilderness setting provide a fitting finale to our Wells Gray adventure.



Retracing our route out of the park, we leave the waterfalls behind and follow the North Thompson Valley south

toward Kamloops, watching the landscape gradually change from lush mountain forests to the rolling hills and open country of BC's Interior. Settle into the Coast Hotel for a relaxing evening after a memorable day surrounded by some of British Columbia's most spectacular natural wonders.

## Day 4

reach Revelstoke for a tour of the impressive Revelstoke Dam Visitor Centre, where the tremendous scale of this 175-metre-high structure is matched by spectacular views across the Columbia River Valley.



Settle into the Coast Hillcrest Hotel, surrounded by beautiful mountain scenery, before gathering for a special Farewell Dinner to celebrate the adventures, spectacular sights and new friendships shared along the way.

## Day 5

### Revelstoke, BC to Home Cities - Homeward bound over mountain passes

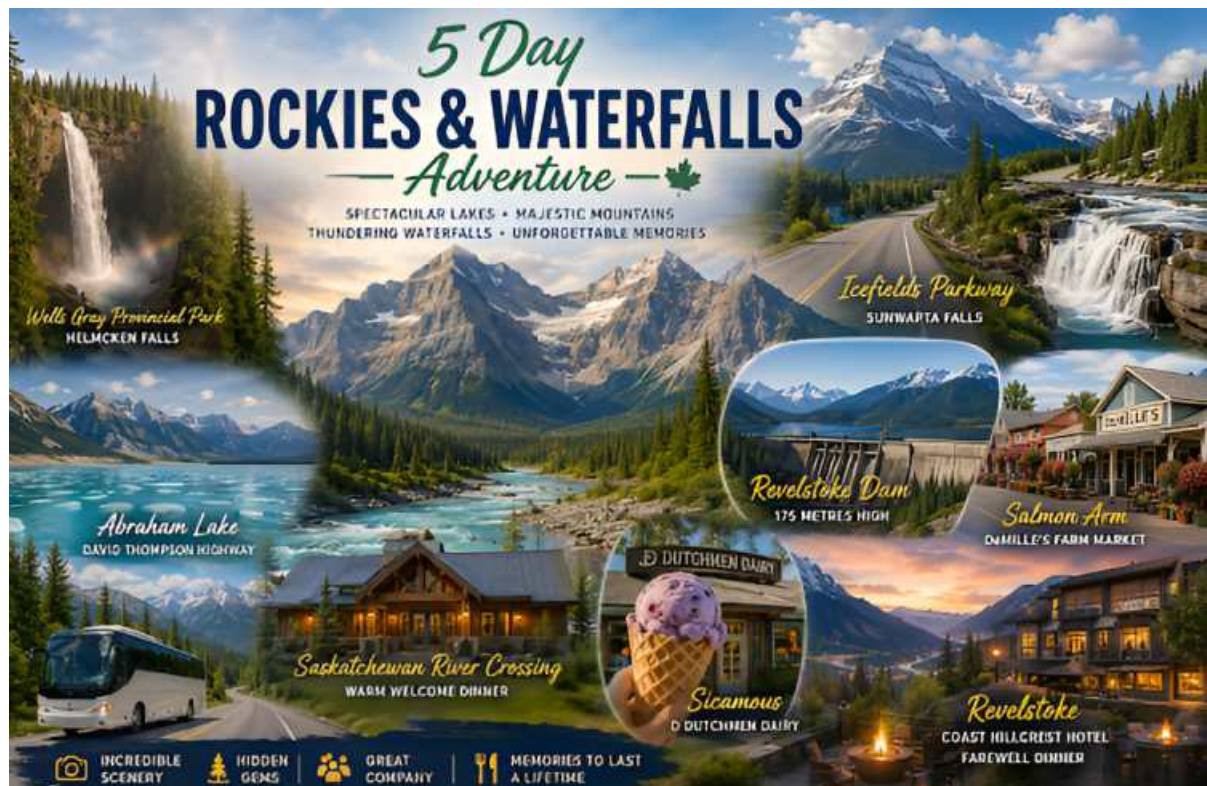

The day concludes at the renowned Harrison Hot Springs Resort, nestled along the shores of beautiful Harrison Lake. Surrounded by mountain scenery and tranquil waters, this lakeside retreat offers the perfect setting to unwind. Enjoy a relaxing evening, take advantage of the resort's famous mineral hot springs, or simply stroll the waterfront and soak in the peaceful atmosphere of this charming resort community.



### Day 5

A visit to one of the region's acclaimed wineries offers a chance to sample local wines while enjoying beautiful vineyard surroundings and discovering the flavours that have earned the Okanagan an international reputation.

Nestled on the shores of Okanagan Lake, the Penticton Lakeside Resort welcomes us for a relaxing two-night stay. Stroll the lakeside promenade, explore the waterfront, or simply settle in and admire the beautiful surroundings of one of British Columbia's favourite resort communities. 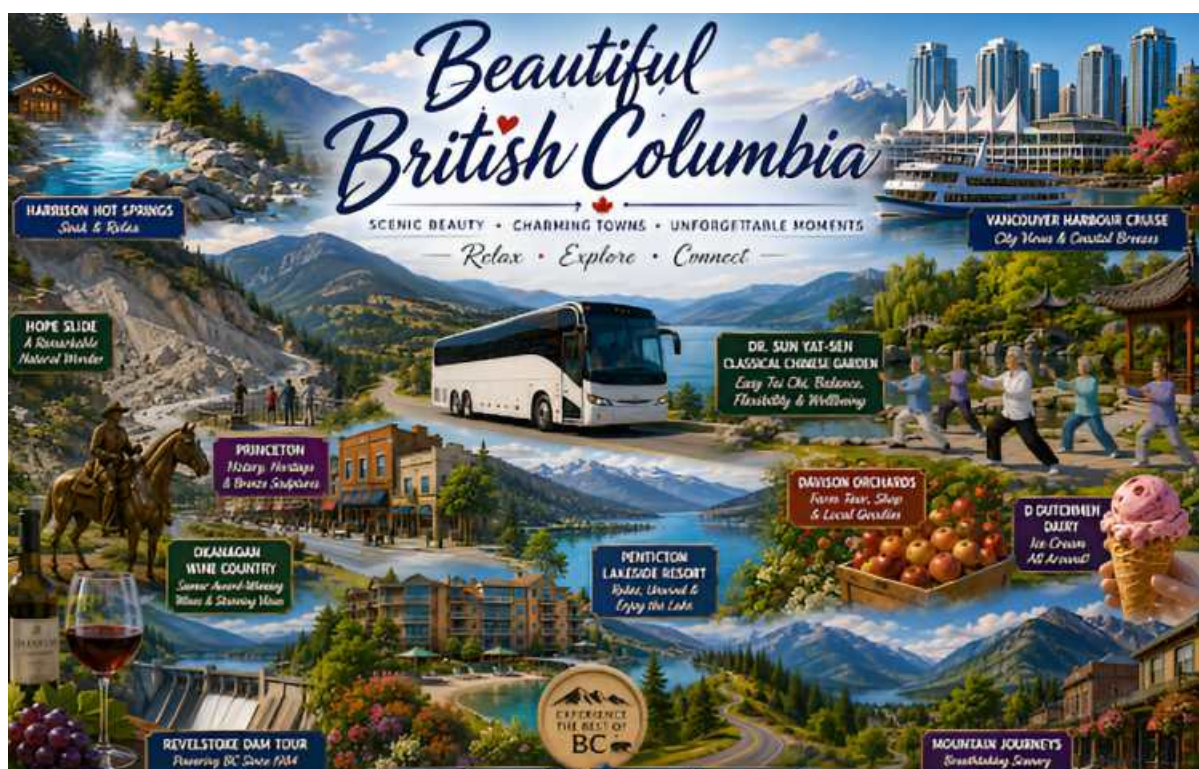

# Frequently Asked Questions

## What is a Guided Group Tour and why should I choose it?

A guided group tour is when a group of people travel together on a preplanned itinerary of transportation, hotel, some meals, and activities. With Pro Tours that often means that a Tour Director accompanies the group as well. A group tour can be a bus tour or a fly-in and bus tour combination.

It is different from independent travel because a tour operator is planning your trip for you. You don't have to worry about booking hotels, paying each supplier, searching for the best activities, or sometimes even where to eat! The most stressful thing you must do is book your trip, pack, and show up the morning of your trip.

## How many people will be on the tour?

For trips to Canada and the United States, our group sizes can vary from 25-50 people. It is unlikely you will have less than 25 or more than 50 passengers.

While they vary, our European tours are typically between 25 – 40 people. It is unlikely that your trip to Europe will be less than 25 people.

## How do I book a trip?

To book a trip with us, please contact us directly via email at [hello@protours.ca](mailto:hello@protours.ca), complete our Contact Us Form or call us at 780-460-4408. We will be happy to assist you with the booking process and answer any questions you may have. We look forward to helping you plan your next adventure!

## When should I book my tour and why is it not guaranteed?

We recommend booking a tour as soon as you are interested in that specific tour. We have many tours that sell out early year after year. It is never too early to reserve a tour but it can be too late. Tour booking cut offs can vary from 30 days to 60 days, so waiting until the last minute is not a possibility.

To guarantee a tour, we must reach minimum numbers of passengers before the date that Pro Tours is required to cancel accommodations and/or attractions without penalty. This can vary anywhere from 30 days to 90 days prior to departure. If we don't receive the minimum number of passengers required by that date the trip will be canceled. Waiting to book your spot until a trip is guaranteed can contribute to a tour being canceled.

## What does it mean when a tour is listed as "Wait List"?

A "Wait List" tour means that the tour is sold out, but we are taking names for a wait list in case there are cancellations. We do this when a tour sells out very quickly, as there are usually some cancellations along the way.

## How can I add my name to the wait list?

To add your name to the wait list, you will need to call or email us directly. We are currently managing wait list requests through these methods.

## Is my deposit non-refundable?

Please refer to our General Terms and Conditions for full details regarding our deposit and refund policy. You can view the document [here](#). If you have any further questions, feel free to contact us.

## Why do single travelers pay more?

If you are traveling by yourself, the costs of hotel accommodations are incurred by one person instead of two. Therefore, single accommodations cost more than "double" and "triple" packages, as they are not divided by 2 or 3 people.

## As a single traveler, do I get the row to myself?

As a single traveler, you are still only paying for 1 seat on the coach, therefore you may have someone seated beside you on the coach. You will be required to rotate window and aisle seats throughout the tour.

## Can I reserve a specific seat on the bus?

We assign seats for customers on the bus from front to back as they book on the tour.

## Do you do seat rotation?

On most tours longer than 4 days, the tour director will do seat rotation allowing for a change of viewing from the other side of the bus and from a different position on the bus.

## What are the buses like?

Our motor coaches generally have 52 seats and are deluxe motorcoaches. All coaches of that size have washrooms, reclining seats, overhead lights, air vents, and televisions. We do not own the motor coaches so we are never sure on the exact model that you will be riding on until days prior to the trip. Common amenities that may be on your coach are cup holders, foot rests, pouches in the seats, electricity plugs and Wi-Fi (Canadian portions of trips only)

## What should I know about Gratuities?

Gratuities are a thoughtful way to show your appreciation for excellent service and are customary in many service industries. While tipping is a common practice, it is entirely voluntary and not included in the tour price unless specifically noted.

Common gratuities during a tour may include:

Restaurant Staff (for meals not included): 15-20% of the bill but never less than \$1.00

Hotel Room Cleaning Staff: \$2-\$5 per stay

Pro Tours – Tour Director/Manager: \$5-\$8 per traveler/day

Coach Driver: \$5-\$8 per traveler/day

Local Guide/Commentator (that is with the group for multiple days): \$5-\$8 per traveler/day

Local Step on Guide: \$2.00- \$4.00 per traveler.

Continue north to Cow Head and settle into Shallow Bay Cabins, surrounded by the wild beauty of Newfoundland’s west coast.

Settle into the charming Historic Glynmill Inn, an enduring part of Corner Brook’s heritage, and gather for an included dinner. our way across the island toward Charlottetown, one of Canada's most charming and historic cities.

Before settling in for the evening, gather for a true Island tradition with an included lobster dinner on the wharf, enjoying fresh Maritime flavours in a classic waterfront setting. From here, it's a short journey to the elegant Rodd Charlottetown, our historic home in the heart of the city.

An early afternoon arrival in Miramichi gives us time to slow the pace and enjoy this beautiful riverside community. Our home for the night is the Rodd Miramichi River, set directly along the banks of the Miramichi River in the heart of downtown. Expansive river views, easy walking access to Historic Water Street and genuine Maritime hospitality make this waterfront hotel the perfect place to settle in and enjoy the rhythm of life along the river.

Take a leisurely stroll along the waterfront or simply relax on your river-facing patio, enjoying the warm fall air and views of the impressive

Centennial Bridge, rising 240 feet above the water and stretching approximately 1.1 kilometres across the Miramichi River. Rooted in Mi'kma'ki, the ancestral homeland of the Mi'kmaq, and enriched by Acadian, Irish, Scottish and English heritage and newcomer cultures, Miramichi is a place where traditions, stories and river life run deep.

Later, it's just a short stroll to experience a true taste of local hospitality at a traditional Miramichi Kitchen Party. Settle in with tea and treats while local entertainers fill the room with music, songs, stories and colourful tales of the region—a warm and memorable evening celebrating the people, traditions and unmistakable spirit of the Miramichi.

## Day 11

### Miramichi to Moncton, NB - Chasing Tides on the Bay of Fundy

Our day remains flexible by design, as Mother Nature sets the schedule along the Bay of Fundy. We'll arrange our sightseeing and other attractions around the best possible opportunity to experience Hopewell Rocks Provincial Park near low tide, ensuring we make the most of our visit to one of New Brunswick's most remarkable natural wonders.

At the Ocean Tidal Exploration Site, witness the extraordinary power of the world's highest tides, where billions of tonnes of seawater continually reshape the coastline. Depending on the tide, we may have the opportunity to descend to the ocean floor and walk among the towering Hopewell Rocks, carved by centuries of wind, water and erosion. Just hours later, the very ground beneath our feet can disappear beneath the rising waters of the Bay of Fundy.





Other sightseeing experiences will be woven into our day once the tidal schedule is confirmed, allowing us to enjoy the region without rushing this unforgettable natural phenomenon. Our journey concludes in Moncton, where our hotel overlooks the Petitcodiac River, another fascinating place to witness the influence of the Bay of Fundy. Settle in and watch the river from above, where the changing tides and famous tidal bore provide one more reminder of the incredible forces of nature that define this corner of Atlantic Canada.

## Day 12

With Pier 21 located right along the waterfront, enjoy lunch on your own from the many nearby choices before an unhurried afternoon along Halifax's Historic Waterfront. Stroll the lively boardwalk, browse local shops, enjoy the harbour views or find a patio and simply watch the waterfront come to life.

This evening, gather together for our Farewell Dinner, sharing favourite stories, plenty of laughs and memories from our journey across Atlantic Canada. It's a chance to raise a glass and bid a fond farewell to your Pro Tours Tour Director, local guide and Coach Atlantic driver, as well as the new friends and fellow travellers who have shared this remarkable adventure. ## DEPOSITS/FINAL DEPOSITS

**INITIAL RESERVATION DEPOSIT** – An initial booking deposit is required upon booking (within 24 hours of booking online) unless otherwise stated on the tour reservation details. This deposit is non-refundable, but transferable as a deposit to another tour if the customer cancels prior to the date listed on your tour reservation.

**SECOND GUARANTEED DEPOSIT** – A second “**guaranteed deposit**” may be required on certain tours and will be non refundable. Tours outside of Canada, all tours with group flights and/or event tickets or special tour inclusions will require a second deposit once the tour reaches guaranteed status. You will be notified by email when this status is reached and must make the second non refundable deposit payment within 3 business days of being notified.

**FINAL PAYMENTS** – remaining balances will be due on the stated final payment date and at this time 100% of the tour price will be non refundable.

In the unlikely event that the tour does not reach the minimum required reservations for the tour to be a guaranteed departure, initial reservation deposits can be moved to another tour, turned into a travel credit or refunded to the customer. Customers will be notified via email if this affects the tour.

## TOUR STATUS

A tour must have a minimum number of passengers reserved for a tour to be a **Guaranteed Departure**. This number differs per tour. Once the tour has reached the guaranteed status, booked passengers will be notified by email (or phone if no email is available). Tours that do not reach this status prior to the final payment date may need to be canceled. In this case, deposits can be transferred to another tour, held as Pro Points or they may be refunded.

## CHANGES TO OCCUPANCY OR TOURS

One (1) occupancy change, and/or tour change will be allowed without an added administration fee. Multiple changes to the reservation may result in an additional administration fee.

## RESERVATIONS MADE AFTER SALES CUT OFF DATE

Any reservations requested after a tour's final payment date, may incur up to a \$100 administration fee depending on the tour with a minimum charge of \$25. Late reservations are not guaranteed to be available. A valid credit card to guarantee payment must be given prior to contacting the suppliers to inquire about availability.

## TOUR PRICES

Tour Prices are quoted in Canadian Dollars (unless otherwise stated), based upon the cost and conditions in effect at the time of printing, and are subject to change.

Casino packages, and any advertised events and attractions are subject to change without notice. The land price of a tour does not include: air travel, airline fees, airport or departure taxes, transfers, pre/post hotels, port charges on cruises or any other incidental charges unless otherwise stated. Items not listed on the tour inclusion list are not included. Any extra lodging due to weather-related conditions or road closures, missed flights, or any other force majeure events would be the customer's responsibility.

## ACCOMMODATIONS

A list of overnight accommodations with phone numbers and addresses will be made available with the final tour itinerary. Nightly accommodations are at good quality motel/hotels and are chosen for cleanliness, service and comfort. Some areas do not offer a large selection of accommodations or may not be equipped with elevators. In this event, we choose the best available and do our best to supply luggage handling if elevators are not available or ground floor rooms. Rooms are allocated by each hotel – if you have a preference (smoking or non-smoking, ground floor, accessible,) please advise at time of booking. **Requests may not always be possible as not all hotels/motels have enough of each type of room to accommodate all requests.** All accommodations are booked on a 1 or 2 bed basis. For Double Occupancy, the number of beds required must be stated at the time of booking. Bed sizes vary depending on the area of the tour and the hotel/motel.

Single.....One Person/One Bed  
Double.....Two Persons/One or Two Beds  
Triple.....Three Persons/Two Beds  
Quad.....Four Persons/Two Beds

## SINGLE TRAVELERS

Since hotel rates are per room, the tour price for rooms occupied by one person is paid by one person, where when two or more persons share a room, the room cost is shared by that many people, therefore the price for the tour is more for single travelers due to hotel room costs. For single passengers looking to share accommodations, Pro Tours will attempt to find a same-gender match for the requested tour. The single rate will be charged the day your tour is booked. If a companion becomes available, your final invoice will be adjusted to Double Occupancy price.

## OPTIONAL GRATUITIES

Gratuities are a tangible way for you to express your appreciation for jobs well done and are common in most service industries. This practice, although customary, is voluntary and is not included in tour prices unless stated.

Gratuities that are commonly incurred while on tour:

Restaurant Staff (for meals not included): 15-20% of the bill but never less than \$1.00

Hotel Room Cleaning Staff – \$2-\$5 per stay

Pro Tours – Tour Director/Manager – \$5-\$8 per traveler/day

Coach Driver – \$5-\$8 per traveler/day

Local Guide/Commentator (that is with the group for multiple days) – \$5-\$8 per traveler/day

Local Step on Guide: \$2.00- \$4.00 per traveler.

Tours outside of North America standards for gratuities may differ and will be specified on the tour information.

## IDENTIFICATION/PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP

Identification is required for all trips and it is your responsibility to obtain and carry the proper documentation. Tours within Canada, a current drivers license or other government issued photo ID is required. Canadian citizens require a valid passport for travel outside of Canada that is at least 6 months away from expiring. **For travel to the United States by a Canadian Citizen, the expiry date of the Canadian passport must be for at least the length of tour,** refer to Customs and Border Protection. Citizens of other countries or landed immigrants, check with the appropriate foreign consulate for entry requirements. Pro Tours is required to give the US Border Crossing a passenger manifest prior to arrival. Pro Tours is not responsible and will not refund any tour costs if a passenger(s) is denied access at the border for any reason. If a passenger(s) is refused entry or detained at the border, the passenger(s) will be responsible for finding transportation home at their own expense.

Please Note: While cannabis is legal in Canada it is illegal to transport cannabis across the Canadian border. This includes medical cannabis. Passengers are not permitted to travel with marijuana/cannabis across any borders while traveling with Pro Tours. Failure to follow this policy will result in the passenger being responsible for their own return home should they be denied entry into the country they are trying to enter, at their own cost, and



they will not be permitted to continue with a tour. Full cancellation charges of the tour will apply. The passenger will also be subject to the legal ramifications of attempting to bring an illegal substance into the country in which they are trying to enter.

#### **SCHEDULE AND ITINERARY CHANGES**

Pro Tours reserves the right to make changes to the published itinerary which may be required due to circumstances beyond our control. The tour organizer reserves the right to make any changes before or during the tour for the comfort, convenience and safety of the passengers. During local or national holidays certain features such as museums, sightseeing tours and shopping may be limited or unavailable. In such instances, and whenever possible, itinerary adjustments and substitutions are made to minimize inconveniences.

#### **FORCE MAJEURE**

Force Majeure Event means any event or circumstance beyond the control of Pro Tours, including but not limited to: (a) an act of god (such as earthquake, flood, fire, explosion, landslide, lightning, action of the elements, force of nature, washout, typhoon, hurricane, cyclone, tsunami, storm or storm warning or natural disaster); (b) industrial disputes, work ban or other labor dispute or difficulty; (c) acts of terrorism, political unrest, war or threat of war, riots or civil strife; (d) failure or delays to scheduled transportation, road closures due to accidents and the closure of airports or ports; (e) pandemic, epidemic or health risk; (f) governmental and administrative actions (including closure of borders and travel warnings and restrictions).

#### **CANCELLATION BY PRO TOURS**

Pro Tours reserves the right to modify or cancel any tour (definite or not), accommodation, in-destination activity or arrangement at any time.

Cancellation due to Failure to Pay - If full payment is not received by the due date (as stated for each specific tour on the order statement), Pro Tours has the right to cancel your reservation and no refund will be made. Pro Tours will not be responsible for lost reservations.

Cancellation due to Force Majeure Events - If Pro Tours cancels a tour as a result of a Force Majeure Event, a future travel credit (FTC) to the value of funds paid to date less any third-party costs incurred will be provided. All FTCs will be valid for 24 months from date of issue.

Where a tour is terminated mid-tour due to a Force Majeure event, if we provide you with any alternative services or assistance (such as hotels or travel) then you agree to pay for these costs.

Cancellation due to Events other than Force Majeure Events - If the cancellation by Pro Tours is not as a result of a Force Majeure Event, but is out of Pro Tours control, an alternative comparable tour (if available) will be offered, if an alternative is not available then a FTC will be given for the portion of tour that has been cancelled. Pro Tours is not liable for any cancellation or change cost or penalties incurred on other travel arrangements, including air travel, that may be affected thereby.

Pro Tours is not responsible for other travel arrangements that you or your party have made outside Pro Tours and which are affected by our cancellations.

Early Return, Illness or Absence - Early return expenses are the guest's responsibility. There is no refund for absence or early departure from a tour, including but not limited to missed hotels, transfers, meals or sightseeing cruises or optional extensions. Pro Tours urges you to purchase travel insurance which covers such circumstances. Pro Tours makes no representation or guarantees concerning reimbursement, scope of coverage, or other aspects of any travel insurance policy or claim.

#### **PRO TOURS RESPONSIBILITIES**

Pro Tours acts as an Agent for the passengers with respect to the dining, attractions, admissions, transportation, and accommodations. Pro Tours will not assume responsibility for any claims, losses, damages, cost or expenses arising out of personal injury, accidents or death, loss, damage or delay of baggage or other property, or delay. We recommend both medical and cancellation/trip interruption insurance (also known as travel and medical protection) for your protection and security. Pro Tours cannot accept responsibility for itinerary changes, changes in accommodations, transportation or attractions, reserving the right to substitute arrangements

as deemed necessary. Pro Tours does not take responsibility for any errors or omissions from any supplier during the tour.

#### **PASSENGER'S RESPONSIBILITIES**

Your responsibility is to sit back and enjoy a care-free holiday. Carefully read all emails or mailings you receive from Pro Tours. Ensure that you know all departure times throughout your tour and be punctual to help keep the tour on time. Pro Tours reserves the right to terminate the trip (at any point) for any passenger whose inappropriate actions, conduct or health adversely affects other passengers, tour directors, suppliers or employees of establishments visited. In this event there will be no TFC for unused portions of the trip and the cost for returning to the point of embarkation will be borne by the passenger.

#### **COACH and GROUP ETIQUETTE/RULES**

For everyone's comfort, health and safety, the following coach and group rules of conduct will be in place – No Smoking/Vaping or Chewing Tobacco on board the bus or any group gathering – Strong Scents, please refrain from wearing strong scented perfumes/colognes, or other scents – No Alcohol consumption or presence on board the bus. Please refrain from conversations while the tour director or tour guide is speaking.

Garbage/water bottles etc. should be disposed of in supplied bags.

#### **SEATING ON THE COACH**

All seating is subject to availability and is assigned from front to back as reservations are made. During most tours, you will be asked to change seats in a rotation system. This is the fairest way to allow everyone access to different views from the coach and make new friends across the aisle. Single clients are expected to share the second seat with another passenger. The seat directly behind the driver is reserved for your Tour Director. People traveling single or triple sit with others to allow couples to sit together. In the case of two people traveling separately, but sharing a row, they will alternate the window and aisle seats.
